Dear parents and carers,

As part of our topic learning, Hedgehog class are visiting Painshill Park on Tuesday 3rd March. We will be taking part in a magical storyteller's fairy tale walk using dance, drama, games and amazing props to act out the story. After lunch we will have the opportunity to explore the park and woodland to have a forest school session which will include bug hunting, finding fairy homes and den building.

Please ensure children are at school promptly as we will be leaving at **8.45am**. We will return by the end of the school day.

The children will be required to wear trousers/jeans, boots/trainers that are comfortable to walk in and their **school jumper**. They will also need a waterproof coat, high-vis vest and packed lunch in a bag that is easy to carry (**no food containing nuts, sweets or fizzy drinks**).

The cost of this trip is £27.61 per child including the coach hire.

We also have another exciting trip planned to Tuesley Farm on Thursday 2nd July. The farm do not charge for their educational visits, therefore the cost of the trip to cover transport will be £2.22. The children will be travelling by minibus. Further details will be sent nearer the time.
