Dear Rabbit class parents and carers,

As part of our history learning this term the children will be attending a workshop in school on Tuesday 11th November provided by Chertsey Museum. They will be bringing toys from the past to explore materials, old fashioned games and past times. There will also be an outdoor session using authentic Victorian toys. The cost of this workshop is £5.84 per child.

In our Science learning in the spring term we will be beginning our topic on plants and growth. To support this, we will be visiting Wisley Gardens on Tuesday 17th March 2026. We will be taking part in a workshop on plants in the morning and we will also be working as a class to identify different types of trees.

The coach will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school by the end of the school day. The cost of this trip will be £19.67 including the coach hire. This includes a £2.03 reduction following the trip to Tuesley Farm last year which worked out slightly less per child than expected.

The children need to be in their school uniform and they will need a waterproof coat, wellies, hi-vis jacket and a packed lunch (**no nuts, sweets or fizzy drinks**). As the children will have to carry their lunch and water bottle with them, please could you make sure it is in a back pack and as light as possible.
