They will develop skills which include tool and wood work, working within a team to complete challenges, gaining an understanding of how to look after their surroundings and what lives and grows in the local environment.

We will be encouraging your child to be active outside, whatever the weather, so please try to kit them out with the necessary clothes and footwear as they may well get muddy! No need for school uniform - the children can come to school in their outdoor clothes.

### Your child will need –

#### To wear

- **School shoes or trainers and their outdoor clothes**

#### To bring

1. **Named** waterproof jacket
2. **Named** waterproof trousers, or old trousers that you don't mind getting muddy!
3. **Named** wellies or waterproof walking type boots (not trainers) in a **named** carrier bag
4. **Named** Long sleeved top and trousers (these are essential)
5. Water bottle
6. The children will be outside for longer than they are used to in school so please dress them in **warm clothes if it is cold**. We can always remove layers but they don't enjoy it if they are cold.

If your child doesn't have waterproof trousers, they **MUST** bring a change of trousers for the rest of the school day.
